Rolling Mouse Trap

Catch rodents in a bucket



1. Drill two holes in opposite sides of a 28 cm diameter bucket (+/- 1 cm). The ideal distance of the holes to the edge is about 1.3 cm.
2. The metal axle of the trap can be pressed into the rotatable roller on one side. Then the trap is simply clamped in the bucket.
3. Attach a food as bait in the middle of the cylinder. Nut-nougat cream, peanut butter and sausage have proven to be quite successful.
4. Attach a wooden plank as a climbing aid to the edge of the bucket. Please do not fill the bucket with water. The trap is a live trap.
5. When a mouse tries to get to the bait, the weight of the animal sets the ball-bearing roller in motion. The mouse loses its hold, falls into the bucket and is trapped in it.
6. Inspect the bucket several times daily for caught mice. Dispose of the animals at least 20 km away from human habitation.
