SlugTrap, Set of 4

Protect your vegetables

The summer is on its way and you have spent hours preparing your vegetable patch, sowing seeds and putting in young plants. Now you can see the first juicy strawberries and home-grown lettuce growing fast. But what is this? Half of a strawberry has already been eaten and the lettuce is beginning to get holes. You start looking and searching for the culprit, but you cannot find it during the day. As soon as dusk falls, the thief will come out of its hiding. Slugs are the most common lettuce, strawberry and vegetable thieves in our gardens. They are nocturnal and during the night they will continuously devour our vegetables. Slugs and snails are also attracted by the smell of beer and it is well worthwhile to sacrifice a few millilitres, if that will stop them from feasting on our vegetables. Pour half a pint of beer into each trap and place it near to your vegetable patch. Slugs and snails will then instinctively approach the trap and be caught.

- 1. Do not place the trap in the centre of your vegetable patch. The smell of beer attracts slugs and it will also attract the snails from neighbouring areas, luring them into your vegetable garden. Place the traps around your vegetable patch to lure the snails away from it. To keep the whole garden free of slugs we recommend that you set up slug traps at regular intervals around the garden.
- 2. Dig the trap into the ground so that the top edge of the cup is flush with the level of the ground.
- 3. Fill the trap with beer and add 2 teaspoons of salt. Cover the trap with the lid.
- 4. Check daily whether you have caught anything and empty the trap if necessary.
