## Insect Hotel XXXL

One home for many insect species

Place the Insect Hotel XXXL in spring or summer in a sunny spot, sheltered from rain in your garden or on the patio. It provides suitable nesting places for a wide variety of insects such as bees, ladybirds, lacewings, butterflies and many more. They will find food in the surrounding garden area, pollinate flowers and feed on bugs and aphids. Some insects may overwinter in the house. Watching the busy buzz and life-cycle of these insects can also be an exciting experience for children. Solitary bees (such as mason bees) like to lay their eggs into the wooden tubes and seal them. In spring the eggs will hatch, the larvae will grow and eventually young bees will hatch. Mason bees appear in April and pollinate fruit trees as well as strawberries. Ladybirds feel very comfortable in the dense material and in summer they will help you fight greenflies. They are active during the day and the insect hotel is a safe place for them to stay at night.
