Insect Hotel “Tree Of Life”

A decorative nesting and overwintering aid

Contribute to the biological balance in your garden by using our Insect Hotel “Tree Of Life”! Natural nesting places for ladybirds, lacewings, mason bees and butterflies are getting increasingly scarce. However, these useful creatures are important for a balanced ecosystem. Bees pollinate the flowers of fruit trees. Ladybirds and lacewings feed on greenflies. The sight of colourful butterflies delights children and adults alike. All these insects will find nesting and overwintering aids at the Insect Hotel “Tree Of Life”. Its decorative housing makes it an eye catcher in any garden. The tree design is a symbol for life itself, as a tree provides habitats for a great variety of small animals which larger animals feed on. Many organisms even benefit from deadwood.

Simply hang the Insect Hotel in a sunny but sheltered place in your garden or on the terrace in spring or summer – ideally in close proximity to shrubs or trees. In the course of time many different insect species may nest in it, e.g. mason bees, butterflies, ladybird bugs and lacewings. They will find food on flowers and shrubs in the garden.
